of the Voluntary Society called the LONDON ANNUITY Society, on the Terms and Conditions of a certain Deed of Agreement made for the Establishing and Government of the faid Society, dated the first Day of January, 1765. AND WHEREAS the faid Meander Waugh --

hath executed the faid Deed, and paid the appointed Premium to the Treasurer of the faid Society, and hath agreed to make the annual Payment of Five Guineas- and alfo all other Payments appointed by the faid Deed, and fubfequent By-Rules, during the Term of his Now this Inftrument, or Policy of Affurance, WITNESSETH, natural :- Life. That in Confideration of the Premifes: WE three of the Truftees of the faid Society for the Time being, Do hereby charge, fubject, and make liable the capital Stock, Fund, Effate, and Effects of the faid Society, with and to the Payment of fuch an Annuity, or yearly Sum of Money, to Mary late Neile Syed thirty one years the first of January 1792 now the Wife of the faid Mexander Waigh during fo long as the thall be and continue the Widow of the faid Moxander Waugh as the by the Terms and Conditions of the faid

Deed, and fubsequent By-Laws, shall upon her faid Husband's Death become entitled unto, in respect of his faid annual Payment of Trive quincas ... and the Time of his being a Member of the faid Society, fuch Annuity to be paid to her by two equal half yearly Payments, the first Payment to become due, and be made on the Second of the four general Quarter Days of the Year which thall first happen after the Decease of her faid Husband, in case he shall have lived one whole Calendar Year from the faid twenty eighth _ Day of March___ 1792. AND we do hereby order, appoint, authorize, and impower the Directors of the faid

Society, for the Time being, to raife and pay fuch Annuity or yearly Sum of Money, from Time to Time accordingly, to the faid *Analy Waugh* by and out of the Monies, Securities, and Effects of the faid Society, according to the Terms of the faid Deed, and fubfequent By-Rules : PROVIDED always, and this Policy is upon these Conditions, That if this Policy hath been obtained by falfe Pretences, or if the faid . Hexander Wadgh ____

shall not duly pay the faid annual Sum of Fine Guineas and the other Payments appointed to be made by him in respect thereof, during the Term of his natural Life, or shall in any Manner ineur a Forfeiture of this Policy, by the Breach or non-Performance of any of the Articles contained in the Deed of Settlement, or fubfequent By-Rules, or in cafe the faid Mar; Waugh - shall marry again, or shall not observe and keep the Rules and Orders of the faid Society, or demean herfelf agrecable to the Terms of the faid Deed, or fubfequent By-Rules; or if any Affignment shall be made of this Policy, or of the Annuity hereby fecured, then and in every such Cafe this Policy shall ceafe and become void to all Intents and Purpofes. IN WITNESS whereof we three of the Truftees of the faid Society have hereunto fet our Hands and Seals, the *Areniq winth* Day of *Juquest* in the *Iniety second* Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord *George the third* of Great-Britain, France and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c.
