Whereas

the Directors of the ECONOMIC LIFE ASSURANCE SOCIETY have agreed with

to Assure his Life against the Life of *Robert William Gyphon of Great Union Street aforesaid Esquire, and for the term of one year after the decease of the said Robert William Gyphon* in the Sum of *Four Hundred and Ninety Nine Pounds* and he hath declared, that on the *fourteenth* Day of *December* Instant the said *Robert William Gyphon* had fully completed his *Sixty First* Year of Age, and that his own Age did not exceed *Twenty Five* Years; and that he has had the Small Pox or Cow Pox, has never had the Gout nor Asthma, nor any Fit or Fits, nor suffered a Spitting of Blood, and is not afflicted with any Complaint, Affection or Disorder, which tends to shorten Life;

And Whereas

the said *William Lyte Gyphon* hath paid at the Office of the said Society the Sum of *Seven Pounds Two Shillings and Six Pence* as a Premium for *Twelve* Calendar Months, commencing on the Day of the Date of this Policy;

Now these Presents witness

That if the said *William Lyte Gyphon* shall Die at any Time within the Term of *Twelve* Calendar Months, to be computed from the Day next before the Day of the Date of this Policy, ~~the said~~ *surviving*, or if they shall ~~both~~ survive the said Term of *Twelve* Calendar Months, and the said *William Lyte Gyphon* shall pay at the Office of the Society the like Premium of *Seven Pounds Two Shillings and Six Pence* on or before the *Twenty Third* Day of *December* next, and at the expiration of every subsequent *Twelve* Calendar Months during his Life, then the Funds and Property of the Society, after Payment of all prior Charges thereon and the Expenses of the Trustees, shall be liable to pay, within Six Calendar Months after proof satisfactory to the Board of Directors of the Society shall have been received at the Office of the Society of the Death of the said *William Lyte Gyphon*, ~~provided he shall not have~~ ^{insured} the said *Robert William Gyphon* for the said term of *one* ~~year~~, unto his Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, the Sum of *Four Hundred and Ninety Nine Pounds* hereby Assured;

Provided always

That if the said *William Lyte Gyphon* shall survive the said *Robert William Gyphon* for the said term of *one* year or shall Die on the Seas, unless passing direct from one Part of the United Kingdom to another, or passing in a decked Vessel from or to any Port in England to or from any Port on the Continent situate between the Texel and Brest, both inclusive, or shall go beyond the limits of Europe, or shall enter into or engage in any Military, Naval, or Preventive Service, without Licence from the Board of Directors of the Society, or shall commit Suicide, or Die by Duelling or the Hands of Justice, or if any thing stated by the said *William Lyte Gyphon* in the Declaration hereinbefore-mentioned to have been made by him shall not be true, this Policy shall be null and void, and the Monies paid on account of this Assurance shall be forfeited.

Provided also,

and it is hereby expressly declared, that the Funds or Property of the Society, after Payment of all prior Charges thereon, shall alone be answerable for the Payment of the Monies assured by this Policy; and that the Trustees of the Society, by whom this Policy is executed, shall not be responsible for Payment of any Monies beyond the Amount of the Funds or Property of the Society in their hands or power more than sufficient for satisfying Assurances previously payable and all their Expenses; and that no Shareholder of the Society shall be liable to any demand against the Society, on any pretence whatsoever, beyond his or her Share of the Capital of the Society; and which Share is set opposite his or her Signature to the Articles for the Settlement of the Society, or mentioned in some other Instrument, declaring him or her to be a Shareholder thereof; and that no Member or Person Assured by the Society shall be liable to any demand against the Society on any pretence whatsoever.

We being the Trustees of the Society, in whose Names the Funds and Property are invested, and not being Shareholders, or beneficially interested in any Assurance made by the Society, have, at the request of the Board of Directors, testified by the Names of two of the Directors hereunto subscribed, set our Hands and Seals, the *Twenty Third* Day of *December* One Thousand Eight Hundred and *Thirty Four*.
