**ANNUAL POLICY for BUILDINGS.**

To all to whom these Presents shall come.

Whereas Thomas George Symmore of 8<sup>th</sup> 1/2  
 Crown Street, Strand - Esquire -

has paid the Sum of £ 1,500 to the Treasurers of the "WESTMINSTER FIRE-OFFICE, for the Insurance of Houses and Buildings, Household Furniture, Goods, and Stock in Trade, from Loss or Damage by Fire," for Insuring from Loss or Damage by Fire, to the Amount of

*One Thousand* Pounds,  
*One Year* from the *Thirteenth* Day of *August*, in the Year of our Lord 1834

And the said *Thomas George Symmore* has proposed to Insure the same for such further Term or respective Terms of ONE YEAR, as shall be mutually agreed on between him and the Directors of the said Insurance-Office for the Time being; And in case of the Renewal or Continuation of this Policy upon Condition that the said *Thomas George Symmore*

his Heirs, Executors, Administrators or Assigns, shall, before the Expiration of the present and every succeeding Term of One Year for which he shall Insure, pay unto the Treasurers of the said Society, for the Time being, the Sum of £ 1,500 Now know Ye, that we, whose Names are hereunto subscribed, and Seals affixed, being Three of the Directors of the said Society, DO hereby (pursuant to the Powers contained in the last Deed of Settlement relating to the said Insurance-Office) order, direct, and appoint the Treasurers of the said Society for the time being, when and as often as the said Buildings, or any other Buildings, of the same Rate, Class, or Denomination, to be erected upon the said Premises, in the Room or Place thereof, shall be burnt down, damaged or destroyed, by or by Means of Fire, during the time that the present Policy shall remain in Force; to pay unto the said *Thomas George Symmore*

his Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, (according to the Nature and Quality of the Property insured,) at the End of Sixty Days after the several Requisites mentioned in the said Deed of Settlement, and stated on the Back of these Presents, shall have been complied with, all such Loss or Damage, (not exceeding however for any such Buildings, the particular Sum herein affixed thereto,) as he, she, or they, shall have sustained by Reason or Means of any such Fire; unless the same shall have happened by Invasion, or any other of the Ways or Means mentioned in the said Deed of Settlement, and on the Back hereof; and unless the Directors for the Time being shall, at the expense of this Society, cause the said Buildings to be rebuilt, repaired, or reinstated, within a reasonable Time, and shall have begun to rebuild, repair, or reinstate the same within such Sixty Days next after Notice of such Fire shall have been given at the Office of this Society, and all necessary requisites shall have been complied with: And it is hereby declared, that this Insurance is made and granted, subject to the several Articles, Stipulations, and Conditions, specified in the said Deed of Settlement, and on the Back of these Presents.
