These presents shall come Thomas Flight

of St Pauls Church House, Walbrook in the City of London Esquire

Tendeth Greeting Whereas

Henry Gore of the Kings Inn barrister

in the County of Middlesex, as Agent to his Grace the Duke of Buckingham and Chandos and the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos being desirous of effecting an Assurance with the said Thomas Flight in the sum of Nine hundred and ninety nine pounds upon the life of the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos, as hereinafter mentioned, and the said Henry Gore thereupon caused to be made to the said Thomas Flight a representation declaring that the age of the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos did not exceed Fifty Years on the day of the date of these presents, that he was of sober and temperate habits, that he had been Vaccinated or inoculated, that he had not had the Gout, that he had not been and is not afflicted with Scurvy, habitual Cough, disease of the Lungs, Asthma, Nephritis, Convulsions, Fits, Insanities, Venereal Complaints of the Liver, or with any other disorder which tends to the shortening of human life, And the said Henry Gore agrees that such declaration and representation should be the basis of this Contract between the Duke of Buckingham and the said Thomas Flight

And whereas the said said Henry Gore on behalf of the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos hath paid to the said Thomas Flight the sum of Eighty three pounds as a premium for the Assurance of the said sum of Nine hundred and ninety nine pounds for twelve Calendar months commencing on the Twenty third day of July One thousand eight hundred and forty seven, and terminating on the twenty third day of July One thousand eight hundred and forty seven both inclusive, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Now therefore these Presents Witness

that in case the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos shall die at any time within the term of twelve Calendar months from the Twenty third day of July instant, and terminating on the Twenty third day of July One thousand eight hundred and forty seven both inclusive, by the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos or his Assigns, shall in the event of the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos living beyond the said term of Twelve Calendar months pay or cause to be paid to the said Thomas Flight, his executors, or administrators, the like premium or sum of Eighty three pounds on the Twenty third day of July One thousand eight hundred and forty seven if he pass the Duke of Buckingham and Chandos shall so long live And also shall and will on every Twenty third day of July in each and every year down to and inclusive of the Twenty third day of July One thousand eight hundred and fifty nine if the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos, shall so long live and truly pay to him the said Thomas Flight, his executors, or administrators, the like sum of Eighty three pounds clear of all deductions, And the said Thomas Flight, his heirs, executors, or administrators, some or one of them shall see well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos, his executors, administrators, or Assigns, the said sum of Nine hundred and ninety nine pounds of lawful money of Great Britain within three Calendar months after said policy, here shall have been received by him the said Thomas Flight, his heirs, executors, or administrators of the death of him the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos, And that if the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos, shall be alive on the Twenty third day of July One thousand eight hundred and fifty and the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos, or his Assigns, shall have well and truly paid the said Annual premium of Eighty three pounds as aforesaid that then the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos, or his Assigns, shall be and become absolutely obliged to be paid the said sum of Nine hundred and ninety nine pounds without any further Annual or other payment in respect thereof, And he the said Thomas Flight, his heirs, executors, or administrators shall and will well and truly pay or cause to be paid the said sum of Nine hundred and ninety nine pounds accordingly And he the said Thomas Flight, doth hereby declare that the monies and property for the time being subject to the trusts of a certain indenture bearing date the Twentieth day of January One thousand eight hundred and forty five, and made between the said Thomas Flight of the one part, and certain Trustees therein named of the other part, and remaining unapplied and undisposed of and inapplicable to prior claims and demands in pursuance of the trusts and powers therein contained shall be answerable for and applicable in the manner and to the extent therein provided to and for the good and benefit of the said Thomas Flight, his heirs, executors, or administrators, in the performance of the Covenants and conditions herein contained but so as not to diminish the capability of the said Thomas Flight, his heirs, executors, or administrators, and heirs, and their property and effects under his Covenants aforesaid, Provided always that these presents and the Assurance hereby effected are and shall be subject to the several conditions and regulations following, that is to say, that the said sum of Nine hundred and ninety nine pounds shall not become payable if the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos shall go beyond the limits of Europe or any where on the high seas excepting in his Majesty's or her Majesty's or his or her Highnesses Fleet, or to or from Ireland, or to or from the Continent of Europe beyond Hamburg and Berne, and without the consent in writing of the said Thomas Flight, his heirs, executors, or administrators, first had and obtained for that purpose, unless the said Thomas Flight, his heirs, executors, or administrators, having a just notice of such going beyond the limits of Europe, or upon the high seas as aforesaid, shall accept payment of any subsequent annual premium, that the said sum of Nine hundred and ninety nine pounds shall not become payable in case any untrue or fraudulent allegation be contained in the representation or declaration above referred to, nor if the said Duke of Buckingham and Chandos shall die by Suicide, Duelling, or by the hands of Justice, that the said Assurance shall not be held to be in force unless the premiums shall have generally been paid to the said Thomas Flight, his heirs, executors, or administrators, nor shall these presents be valid for more than Thirty days after the period limited for the payment of the premiums respectively, Witness it is whereof the said Thomas Flight hath hereunto set his hand and Seal this the Fifth day of August, One thousand eight hundred and forty six,
