This Policy of Assurance witnesseth, THAT Whereas

Richard Webster Junor of Hackney in the County of Middlesex Gentleman
being interested in the ~~Life~~ ^{Lives} of *William Doby of No. 33 Angel Alley Bishopsgate Street Silk Weaver and Alice Doby his Wife*
and being desirous of making an Assurance thereon, for the *Joint Continuance thereof*
has subscribed, or caused to be subscribed, and delivered into the UNION LIFE OFFICE, Cornhill, in the City of London, a Declaration, setting forth the ordinary and present State of Health of the said *William Doby and of the said Alice Doby* wherein it is declared, that the Age of the said *William Doby* did not then exceed *Sixty four* Years; and that the age of the said *Alice Doby* did not then exceed *Sixty three* Years; and having paid to the Directors of the said Office the Sum of *Eleven Pounds sixteen Shillings*
as a Consideration for the Assurance of the Sum under mentioned, for *One Year*, from the *eleventh* Day of *May* 1820

Now know all Men by these Presents, That in Case ^{either} the said *William Doby or Alice Doby* shall happen to die, at any Time within the Term of *One Year*, as above set forth, the Stock and Funds of the said UNION LIFE OFFICE shall be subject and liable to pay, and make good to the said *Richard Webster Junor* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, within *Three Months* after the Demise ^{either} of the said *William Doby or the said Alice Doby* shall have been duly certified to the Directors aforesaid, at their said Office, the Sum of *One Hundred Pounds* of lawful Money of Great Britain.

AND it is hereby further agreed, that this Policy may be continued in force *from Year to Year*, until the Expiration of the Term first above mentioned, provided the said Assured shall duly pay, or cause to be paid, to the Directors, at their said Office, on or before the *eleventh* Day of *May* next ensuing, the Sum of *Eleven Pounds sixteen Shillings* and the like Sum annually, on or before the Day aforesaid; which *Annual Payments* shall be accepted, at every such Period, as a full Consideration for such Assurance.

Provided Nevertheless, That should ^{either of} the said Assured depart beyond the Limits of Europe, die upon the Seas, (except in a Government Packet, between *Great Britain and Ireland*) or engage in any Military or Naval Service whatsoever, within the Term for which this Policy is granted; or should the Assurance have been obtained through any Misrepresentation of the Age, State of Health, or Description of the Assured; then this Policy, and every thing appertaining thereto, shall cease, be void, and of none Effect.

Provided always, And it is hereby expressly agreed and declared, and the true Intent and Meaning hereof is, That the Capital Stock and Fund of the said UNION LIFE OFFICE shall alone be answerable to the Demands thereupon, under this Policy; and that no Member of the UNION SOCIETY shall be liable to any Demands under this Policy; nor shall any Holder of a Share in the ADDITIONAL CAPITAL be liable beyond his Share thereof; and which Share is set opposite to his Signature to the *Deed of Settlement*, establishing the said UNION LIFE OFFICE; any thing contained in this Policy to the contrary notwithstanding.
