By the GOVERNOR and COMPANY of the LONDON ASSURANCE OF HOUSES AND GOODS FROM FIRE.

In the Name of God, Amen. *John Cecil of St. George's*
Dorset Square (himself) make Assurance, and cause *himself* to be assured upon *the* Natural Life of
Peter Bennet of Slsworth Gent.

aged *Forty five Years* for and during the Term and Space of *twelve* Calendar Months, to commence this *Eighteenth*
Day of *July* in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and *Fifty One*
and fully to be compleat and ended. And it is Declared, that this Assurance is made to
and for the Use, Benefit, and Security of the said *John Cecil* his Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, in Case of the Death of the said *Peter Bennet*
which the above Governor and Company do allow to be a good and sufficient Ground and Inducement for the making
this Assurance; and do agree that the Life of *him* the said *Peter Bennet*
is and shall be rated and valued at the Sum Assured, without any farther Account to be given to them for the same:
The said Governor and Company therefore, for and in Consideration of *Five Pounds*
per Cent. to them paid, do assure, assume, and promise, that he the said *Peter Bennet*
shall, by the Permission of Almighty God, live, and continue in this Natural Life, for and
during the said Term and Space of *twelve* Calendar Months, to commence as aforesaid; or in De-
fault thereof, that is to say, in case he the said *Peter Bennet* shall in or du-
ring the said Time, and before the full End and Expiration thereof, happen to die or decease out of this World by any
Ways or Means whatsoever, That then the abovesaid Governor and Company will well and truly satisfy, content,
and pay unto the said *John Cecil* his Executors, Administrators, or
Assigns, the Sum or Sums of Money by them Assured, and here underwritten, abating Two Pounds per Cent.
Hereby promising and binding themselves and their Successors to the Assured, his Executors, Administrators,
and Assigns, for the true Performance of the Premises, confessing themselves paid the Consideration due unto
them for this Assurance by the Assured.

Provided Always, And it is hereby declared to be the true Intent and Meaning of this Assurance, and this
Policy is accepted by the said *John Cecil* upon Condition
that the same shall be utterly Void and of no Effect, in case the said *Peter Bennet*
shall exceed the Age of *Forty five Years* or shall voluntarily go to Sea, or into the Wars, by
Sea or Land, without License in Writing first had or obtained for his so doing, any Thing in these Presents to the
contrary hereof, in any wise notwithstanding. In Witness whereof the said Governor and Company have caused
their Common Seal to be hereunto affixed, and the Sum or Sums by them assured, to be here underwritten, at
their Office in London, this *Eighteenth* Day of *July* in the *twentieth* Year of
the Reign of our Sovereign Lord *George the Second* by the Grace of God, of Great-Britain, France and
Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. And in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and

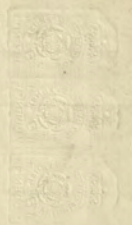
