1 — 27<sup>th</sup> A. Whereas Ann Poisson of Liverpool Widow

hath paid the Sum of *Six Shillings* to the Society of the **MANCHESTER FIRE-OFFICE**, and has agreed to pay or cause to be paid to them at their said Office, the Sum of *Six Shillings* on the *Twenty fifth of March 1771*

and the like Sum of *Six Shillings* yearly on the *Twenty fifth of March* during the Continuance of this Policy, for Insuranc<sup>e</sup> from Los<sup>s</sup> or Damage by Fire, on *her House only situate fronting the South End of S. Georges Dock in Liverpool aforesaid in the Tenure of Woodrowe, Widow & others / hazardous Goods therein / Which and stated*

Now know ye, That from the Date of these Presents, and so long as the said *Ann Poisson* shall duly pay, or cause to be paid, the said Sum of *Six Shillings* at the Times and Place aforesaid ; and the Trustees or Acting Members of the said Society, for the Time being, shall agree to accept the same, the Stock and Fund of the said Society shall be subject and liable to pay to the said *Ann Poisson* her Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, all such *her* Damage and Los<sup>s</sup> which *she* the said *Ann Poisson* shall suffer by Fire, not exceeding the Sum of *Two Hundred* Pounds, according to the exact Tenor of their Printed Proposals, dated *December* the Twenty-sixth, 1771. In witness whereof, we (Three of the Trustees or Acting Members for the said Society) have hereunto set our Hands and Seals, the *Twentieth* Day of *April* 1771.
