Whereas Mess^{rs} Gregson and Garbutt, of Sunderland near the Sea, in the County of Durham, Gentlemen,

have paid the Sum of One pound Three Shillings and Three pence to the Society of the NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE FIRE OFFICE, and do agree to pay, or cause to be paid to the said Society at their Office in Newcastle upon Tyne, the Sum of One pound

on the *Twenty fourth* Day of *June*, 1784, and the like Sum of *One pound* yearly on the *Twenty fourth* Day of *June* during the Continuance of this Policy, as a Premium for the Insurance from Loss or Damage by Fire, of *One thousand pounds* on their

House situate in the Parish of St. Andrew, Sunderland aforesaid, and extending Backwards, namely: One thousand pounds on a House in the Tenure of Anthony Perkins and others. One thousand pounds on a House in the Tenure of John Swanson, and others. Twenty pounds on a House in the Tenure of Mary Appley. One hundred pounds on a House in the Tenure of James Duff. Fifty pounds on a House in the Tenure of Robert Chapman. One thousand pounds on a House in the Tenure of David Meland and others. One thousand pounds on a House in the Tenure of George Thompson and others. Fifty pounds on a House in the Tenure of John Wood and others. One hundred and fifty pounds on a House in the Tenure of Richard Whippley, Thomas Wood and others. One hundred pounds on a House in the Tenure of James Proggal, and another a Public House. All mainly adjoining the Sea last named, situate in the Parishes of St. Andrew, St. Nicholas, and St. Peter, Sunderland aforesaid.

Now know all Men by these Presents, That from the Day of the Date hereof, until the said *Twenty fourth* Day of *June*, 1784, and so from Year to Year, so long as the said Mess^{rs} Gregson and Garbutt shall duly pay, or cause to be paid, the Sum of *One pound* at the Times and Place aforesaid, and the same shall be accepted by the Trustees or Acting Members of the said Society for the Time being, The Stock and Fund of the said Society shall be subject and liable to pay to the said Mess^{rs} Gregson and Garbutt, their

Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, all such Damage and Loss which the said Mess^{rs} Gregson and Garbutt shall suffer by Fire, not exceeding the Sum of *One thousand pounds* according to the exact Tenor of the Deed of Copartnership, entered into by the Members of the said Society inrolled in the high Court of Chancery, of the Printed Proposals of the said Society, dated the *Twenty second* Day of *January*, 1783, and of an Act of Parliament of the 22d Geo. 3d, for charging a Duty on Persons whose Property shall be Insured against Loss or Damage by Fire. In Witness whereof, we (Three of the Trustees or Acting Members for the said Society) on Behalf of ourselves, and all other the Members of the said Society, have hereunto set our Hands and Seals the *Twenty sixth* Day of *April*, 1783.

Received at the same Time, pursuant to an Act of Parliament, the sum of *One pound* being the Duty on the foregoing Insurances, Induced by this Policy, from *the day of the date hereof* 1784.
