Whereas, *M^{rs} Isabella Woodhouse Liferentrix*, and *M^r John Johnston of Grange Trier* hath paid the Sum of *Four shillings and four pence sterling* to the SOCIETY of the EDINBURGH FRIENDLY INSURANCE AGAINST LOSSES BY FIRE, and has agreed to pay, or cause to be paid to them, at their OFFICE in EDINBURGH, the Sum of *Four shillings* at the Term of *Martinmas 1778.* and the like Sum of *Four shillings* at the said Term of *Martinmas* yearly, during the Continuance of this Policy for Insurance from Loss or Damage by Fire, on *a*

Dwelling house being the second story down stairs in the West entry of James's Court, and on the West side of the said stair, presently possess'd by the said John Johnston all stone and slated not exceeding Two hundred pounds sterling.

NOW KNOW YE, That, from the Date of these Presents, and so long as the said *M^{rs} Isabella Woodhouse & John Johnston* shall duly pay, or cause to be paid, the said Sum of *Four shillings* at the Term and Place aforesaid, and the DIRECTORS of said SOCIETY for the Time being shall agree to accept the same, The Stock of the said SOCIETY shall be subject and liable to pay to the said *M^{rs} Isabella Woodhouse & John Johnston their* Heirs, Executors, or Assignees, All such *their* Damage and Loss, which *they* the said *M^{rs} Isabella Woodhouse & John Johnston* shall suffer by Fire, not exceeding the Sum of *Two hundred* Pounds, according to the Tenor of the printed Proposals issued by said SOCIETY, bearing Date the 15th Day of May 1775. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, We (three of the ORDINARY DIRECTORS of the said SOCIETY for the Time being) have subscribed these Presents, AT EDINBURGH the *Twentieth* Day of *October* in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and seventy *Seven*.
