and Loss, which he the said John Berry, One Hundred
shall suffer by Fire, not exceeding the Sum of
Pounds, according to the exact Tenor of their Printed Proposals. IN WITNESS
whereof, WE, (Three of the Trustees or Acting Members of the said Society) have
hereunto set our Hands and Seals, the 27th Day of January 1813
