hath paid the Sum of *Fifteen Shillings* to the Society of the **BRISTOL CROWN FIRE-OFFICE**, and has agreed to pay, or cause to be paid to the said Society at their Office in the City of *Bristol*, the Sum of *Fifteen Shillings* on the *Twenty fourth* Day of *June 1740* and the like Sum of *Fifteen Shillings* Yearly, on the *Twenty fourth* Day of *June* during the Continuance of this Policy, for Insuranc from Loss and Damage by **FIRE** on *this*

*now dwelling House known by the sign of the Merchants Arms, and on a House or Tenement adjoining now building, being design'd for the use of a private family, situate on the Key in the parish of St. Stephen in the City of Bristol six hundred pounds. that is to say*

*On the House known by the Sign of the Merchants Arms Three Hundred pounds*  
*And on the House now building as aforesaid Three Hundred pounds*

Now know ye, That from the Date of these Presents, and for so many Years next ensuing, as the said *George James* shall duly pay, or cause to be paid, the said Yearly Sum of *Fifteen Shillings* at the Times and Place aforesaid; and the acting Members of the said Society, for the Time being, shall agree to accept the same, the Stock and Fund of the said Society and Co-Partners shall be subject and liable to pay the said *George James* Executors, Administrators, and Assignees, all such their Damage and Loss which the said *George James* shall suffer by **FIRE**, not exceeding the Sum of *six Hundred* Pounds, according to the Tenour of the Society's printed Proposals, bearing Date the *Twenty-fourth* Day of *December, 1734*.
