*his* Heirs, Executors,  
Administrators, and Assigns, within fifteen Days after every  
Quarter-Day, in which *he* shall suffer by Fire, *his*  
Loss not exceeding the Sum of *Five* Hundred Pounds. **In**

hereunto set our Hands and common Seal, the *Thirteenth*  
Day of *April* in the Year of our Lord 1719
