To all to whom This Instrument or Policy of Insurance shall come, We, whose Names are hereunto subscribed, being three of the Directors of the NORWICH UNION SOCIETY for the Insuring of Buildings and Goods from Loss and Damage by Fire, send greeting. **Whereas** John Shurborn of Sutton (Cambridgeshire, Germany, Mortgage) and Hugh W. Evans of Ely (Cambridgeshire, Genl. Mortgage) have agreed to become Members of the said Society, and to insure the under-mentioned Property from Loss and Damage by Fire, upon the terms prescribed by the said Society; and have accordingly paid to the Secretary, or an Agent of the said Society, the Premium and Duty above stated; NOW THESE PRESENTS WITNESS that the Capital Stock and Funds of the said Society shall be subject and liable to make good all such Loss and Damage as shall happen to the said Property by Fire (not occasioned by Invasion or Foreign Enemies, or by any Military or Usurped Power, or by any Civil Commotion, or Riot or Tumult) between the day of the date of these presents, and the twenty fifth day of March which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight hundred, and nine, not exceeding the amount hereunder-mentioned; that is to say,

Sixty Pounds on a dwelling house in the occupation of the said John Shurborn situate near Silk Gate in Sutton a forced Brick & timber built and thatched. Twenty pounds on a Lodge and Cart house adjoining each other near the above but separate Brick Timber and thatched.

And that if the said Insured, his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns, shall at the end of the said period, or within fifteen days after, pay to the Secretary, or some Agent for the time being, of the said Society, the like Premium and the Duty, the Capital Stock and Funds of the said Society shall continue liable to make good such Loss and Damage as aforesaid for another year; and thenceforth so long as the said Insured, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, shall, yearly, on the said twenty fifth day of March or within fifteen days after, continue to pay the said Premium and Duty, and the Directors of the said Society shall accept the same, the Capital Stock and Funds of the said Society shall remain liable to make good such Loss and Damage as aforesaid. IN WITNESS whereof, We, three of the said Directors, have hereunto set our hands and seals, the twelfth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight hundred, and eight.
